Owner IASCB Governance	Status Public policy	Review Annual or as required
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Eligibility

Applicants should demonstrate subject knowledge, adult-learning capability, relevant delivery experience and competence in the standards or schemes requested.

Evidence to submit

Provide a CV, qualifications, course outlines, delivery records, learner feedback, references and evidence of continuing professional development.

Impartiality

Disclose relationships or commercial interests that could affect the objectivity of course content, assessment or learner outcomes.

Approval

IASCB may review course materials, observe delivery or request an interview before confirming approval.

Ongoing duty

Approved trainers must keep content current, protect learner information and maintain the competence required for their approved subjects.
